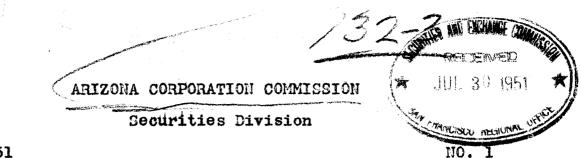

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General Orders Issued

- No. 242 Rescinds all General Orders, amendments thereto, and all rules, regulations or resolutions adopted in connection with or pursuant to Chapter 53, Articles 10 and 11, ACA 1939 as amended (Investment Company Act and Dealers in Securities Act). Effective June 16, 1951.
- No. 243 Requires filing of advertising and sales literature with the Commission one (1) day prior to its use, and establishes certain standards in respect to such material.
- No. 244 Establishes an exemption under Section 5 for securities offered exclusively to employees and/or existing shareholders of an issuer in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 and prescribes the conditions of such exemption.
