Dear Mr. von Schmeling:

This is in further response to your telephone inquiry of February 17 and letter of February 23, 1977.

First, the Commission has never received any list containing the names of foreign officials who may have received payments from Lockheed.

Second, with respect to your inquiry regarding documents reflecting payments to Messrs. Evans, Fife, Robbins and Meuser in connection with Lockheed business in Germany, I instructed my staff to review thoroughly once again our investigative files in this matter. I have been advised that, with the exception of certain workpapers of Lockheed's auditors, all documents in our possession which relate to Lockheed activities in Germany have been furnished to the United States Department of Justice for transmission to the German Government, pursuant to the September, 1976 agreement between your Government and our Department. These workpapers will be furnished to the Department of Justice as soon as possible.
